Viticulture:

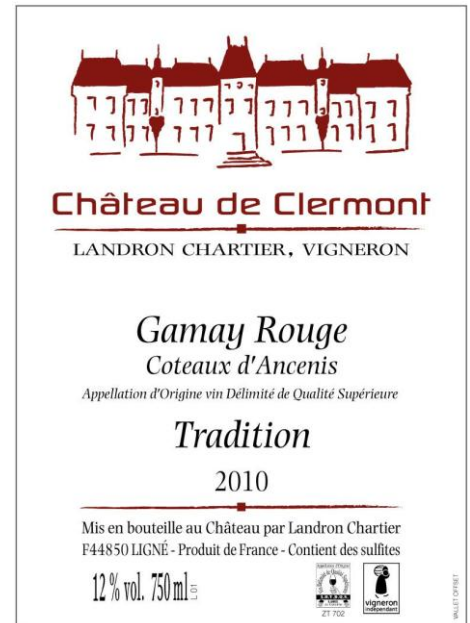
- Practicing Organic
- In Conversion to Organic Agriculture Certification
- Natural yeast fermentation, no pesticides, chemical or other additives except sulphur, copper and other organic compounds in the vineyard; a little sulphur again at bottling
- Harvested at the highest phenolic ripeness. At this moment pips become fruity.

Vinification and Ageing:

- Mechanical harvesting.
- 70% destemming, traditional maceration during 10 days
- Ageing 7 months in vats.
- **Production:** 333 Cases



One of two vineyard locations for Landron Chartier, the Clermont Castle is located in Le Cellier, close to Nantes (18 kilometres). It's built on a spur rock named "Mont Clair". It's southern aspect, which overlooks the Loire River, offers a panoramic view over the Pays des Mauges and the Pays de Retz. All vineyard plots are vinified individually. The Ponceau Castle is located on a schist (flakey mineral soil) valley and provides a soil that typifies Muscadet.
