Landron Chartier Chateau de Clermont “Tradition” Muscadet Coteaux de la Loire Sur Lie 2010

- **Grape Variety:** 100% Melon de Bourgogne
- **Age of the Vines:** Between 20 to 40 years
- **Soils:** Gneiss & Orthogneiss
- **Yield:** 45 hectolitres per hectare
- **Climate:** Maritime

Viticulture: Practicing Organic

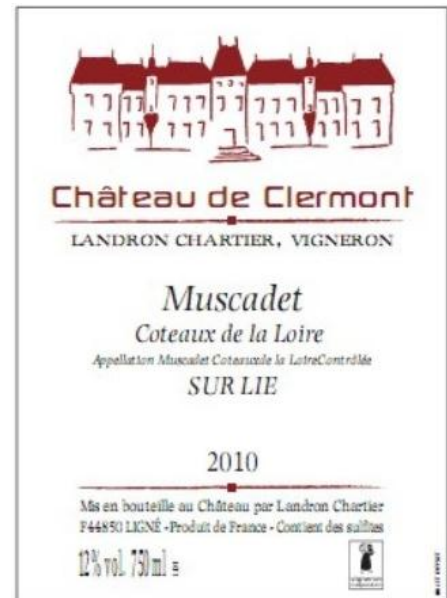
- In Conversion to Organic Agriculture Certification
- Hand harvesting, natural yeast fermentation, no pesticides, chemical or other additives except sulphur, copper and other organic compounds in the vineyard; a little sulphur again at bottling.

Vinification and Ageing Process:

- Harvesting of ripe grapes, pneumatic pressing.
- Cold settling between 150 and 200 NTU.
- The juice rests 5 days under 8⁰C. Alcoholic fermentation at 19⁰C
- Ageing at least six months in vats.
- **Production:** 1083 Cases



One of two vineyard locations for Landron Chartier, the Clermont Castle is located in Le Cellier, close to Nantes (18 kilometres). It's built on a spur rock named "Mont Clair". It's southern aspect, which overlooks the Loire River, offers a panoramic view over the Pays des Mauges and the Pays de Retz. All vineyard plots are vinified individually. The Ponceau Castle is located on a schist (flakey mineral soil) valley and provides a soil that typifies Muscadet.
